The University of Western Australia MD program allows students to have clinical contact from their first year of study and also includes a significant research component. Medical students at UWA come from a variety of backgrounds, which results in an incredibly diverse learning experience. Students within the program have the opportunity to study at one of twelve rural sites, which together comprise the most widespread Rural Clinical School in Australia.

Program Highlights

Year-one Community Placement Program:

Within the first year of the MD program there is a Foundations of Clinical Practice unit which provides a holistic view of health. The unit focuses on communication and interviewing skills in a health care setting; and the role of community-based health agencies. The aim of the program is to supplement classroom learning with opportunities to observe the way health professionals communicate and provide care for their clients/patients in a community setting.

- Promote teaching and learning to the highest international standards
- Contribute to culturally safe health-care and health-care practices
- Increase understanding, prevention and effective management of disease
- Development of knowledge in the biomedical and health sciences within the multi dimensional views of health.
