University of Melbourne is offering scholarships to degree-seeking students lodging applications exclusively through AustraLearn. These scholarships are made available to students commencing degree programs in 2012 only; one awarded in the first semester and one in the second semester. The value of each scholarship is \$1000 AUD. Recipients of the awards will have the monies applied directly to their university account.

Eligible candidates include the following:

- US or Canadian residents who have applied to University of Melbourne via AustraLearn
- Applicants applying to undergraduate or postgraduate studies, in any academic area
- Applicants applying to coursework or research degree programs
- A cumulative GPA from previous studies (i.e. high school/secondary school, Bachelor, or Masters degree) of 3.0/4.0 or 75%.
- Correctly complete the scholarship application, including essays and original signature.

All February 2012 scholarship applications must be received within the AustraLearn office on or before Monday, **January 2, 2012**. All July 2012 scholarship applications must be received within the AustraLearn office on or before Monday, **April 30, 2012**. A complete scholarship application includes the following: application form with an original signature and four essay responses, provided on four separate sheets of paper.

Question 1: (½ Page Maximum) On a separate sheet, provide a narrative that explains your financial need. Include expected income and expenses for the period that you will be studying at University of Melbourne and reasons why you may have any unmet need. You may also make note of any scholarships, grants, or loans that have been awarded to you or any other source for the period of time that you will be studying at University of Melbourne.

Question 2: (1 Page Maximum) On a separate sheet, describe your recent work and study history, any extracurricular activities you are involved with such as clubs, volunteer or sports. Include any academic or employment awards you have received.

Question 3: (½ Page Maximum) On a separate sheet, describe why you chose to study at University of Melbourne.

Question 4: (½ Page Maximum) On a separate sheet, describe your educational and vocational career plans and how this experience will affect your future career. You might also consider how your experience abroad will personally impact you.
